## UMC Extends Flu Vaccinations Due To High Demand, Thursday, Friday At El Paso County Coliseum

El PASO, TX: University Medical Center of El Paso has EXTENDED its special "drive-through" flu vaccination event, due to overwhelming demand for vaccinations.

El Pasoans can be vaccinated from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Oct. 8 and 9 at the El Paso County

Coliseum for children and adults (ages 4 and up). El Pasoans can remain in their cars and safely vaccinated for this year's flu season.

Most insurance will cover the cost of each vaccination, however for anyone wanting self-pay or uninsured, the cost is only \$10. This year, the flu season arrives in the middle of the COVID-19 pandemic. This year, it's FluVid Season.

- Get your flu vaccination on Oct. 8 and 9 at the El Paso County Coliseum.
- Get your entire family vaccinated for the flu. Stay healthy to keep El Paso Strong.
