

Vaccination Success: El Paso, UMC Get National Attention

UMC's Dr. Joel Hendryx, Chief Medical Officer (top right), was interviewed this morning for an NBC News segment about El Paso's successful vaccination rates, among the highest in the nation for cities of its size and larger.

As of this week, El Paso has a vaccination rate of over 75 percent for those 12 and older. For those 65 and older, El Paso is at 89 percent. Amazing.

UMC has given approximately 300,000 vaccinations community-wide -- fortifying other vaccination efforts by the city, county, private pharmacies, and others. The segment was set to air on Monday, locally and nationally.
