- Home to our region's only Level 1 Stroke Center and Joint Commission-certified Comprehensive Stroke Center, able to treat and care for the most complex brain injuries. No other hospital in West Texas, the entire State of New Mexico or anywhere in Southern Arizona has this certification.
- Two stand-alone Emergency Departments located on the northeast and east side of El Paso.
- Our region's first Level 4 Maternal Care and nationally certified Baby-Friendly hospital. The highest rated maternal care hospital in our city.
- We have the most advanced Mobile Stroke Unit (MSU) in the world. A world-class Mobile Stroke Unit that works in tandem with the El Paso Fire Department and 911, and may look like an ambulance, but inside contains specialized equipment, staff and medications specifically tailored to the diagnosis and treatment of a stroke.
- Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner Services (SANE) is the first and only certified full-time 24/7 program in El Paso for acute sexual assault victims.

- Rehabilitation Services representing the largest rehab department in the city with four locations on the west, northeast, east, and main campus with physical therapy, occupational therapy and speech language pathology.
- Neuro/Spine Center brings a higher level of care to El Paso, West Texas and Southern New Mexico with its team of all board-certified and board-eligible neurosurgery medical staff in the El Paso region.
- Regional Laboratory is a state of the art clinical and anatomical lab specializing in diagnostic testing where we interpret and evaluate diagnostic biopsies, as well as gynecologic and non-gynecologic cytology preparations.
- We provide Geriatrics care with a multidisciplinary team of healthcare professionals led by a geriatrician.
- UMC Digestive Health Center has become a referral center for gastroenterologists across West Texas and Southern New Mexico.
- As an accredited Chest Pain Center by the ACC Accreditation Services, our team of experts use state-of-the-art technology and are able to provide high quality, affordable healthcare to the El Paso community.
- Neurosurgery is the cutting edge of innovative surgical techniques to reduce pain and minimize recovery time. UMC has the largest team of neurosurgeons in the region.
- Women's Health Resource Centers
- Mobile Health Clinic, equipped to be of service to rural areas.
- The West Texas Regional Poison Center (WTRPC) is America's first 24-hour bilingual regional poison control center certified by the American Association of Poison Control Centers and is an integral partner in the Texas Poison Center Network.
